Do you know about the NJ Pediatric Psychiatry Collaborative (NJPPC)?

900+ PEDIATRIC CARE PROVIDERS PARTICIPATE IN THE NJPPC, RECEIVING **FREE** TIMELY ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTH CARE SUPPORT AND RESOURCES IN THEIR COMMUNITIES.

The NJPPC is a statewide program that aims to increase the comfort and care of the pediatric providers. Providing confidence to screen, identify, and manage care for children with mental health and substance use concerns.

NJPPC members refers patients needing mental health consultation to their NJPPC Regional Hub.

Hub licensed clinicians, psychiatrists, and other mental health professionals work one on one with families of children and young adults up to the age of 21y by assessing their level of need and providing referrals to appropriate community resources.
