#### Consultative Support and Referral

- Licensed mental health professionals (e.g., LCSWs & LPCs), to assist with identification and assessment of symptoms and care coordination
- "Curbside Consults with a CAP\*", for diagnostic clarification or treatment initiation/management
- One-time **FREE** psychiatric evaluation (as warranted by the CAP) with ongoing collaboration for cases seen

#### Education and Training

- Continuous education opportunities in screening, management, treatment and care coordination of common child and adolescent mental/behavioral health issues
- CME presentations and Learning Collaborative topics include: ADHD, depression, anxiety, suicidal thinking & behavior, among others
- Monthly opportunities to obtain CME credits
- Regional Live CME dinner events featuring NJPPC CAP'S




#### Tele-Psychiatry

- Registered providers are eligible to receive a free iPad to implement tele-psychiatry and Curbside with a CAP services
- Patients referred and eligible for a CAP evaluation can access appointments via:
- Tele-psychiatry at their home or in their provider's office
- In-person at Hub office
