Consultative Support and Referral

 \cdot Licensed mental health professionals (e.g., LCSWs & LPCs), to assist with identification and assessment of symptoms and care coordination

• "Curbside Consults with a CAP*", for diagnostic clarification or treatment initiation/management

 One-time FREE psychiatric evaluation (as warranted by the CAP) with ongoing collaboration for cases seen
 *Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist



Education and Training

· Continuous education opportunities in screening, management, treatment and care coordination of common child and adolescent mental/behavioral health issues

• CME presentations and Learning Collaborative topics include: ADHD, depression, anxiety, suicidal thinking & behavior, among others

Tele-Psychiatry

- · Registered providers are eligible to receive a free iPad to implement tele-psychiatry and Curbside with a CAP services
- Patients referred and eligible for a CAP evaluation can access appointments via:
- · Tele-psychiatry at their home or in their provider's office
- · In-person at Hub office
